## Curamus School for Autism – Disability tax medical credits

The South African Revenue Service allows parents of children with disabilities to claim additional expenses against their taxable income. This is subject to certain conditions and supporting documents to be submitted each year. We specialise in the whole process of claiming these additional expenses, ensuring that it is in the correct format and also maximizing the amount claimed from SARS.

Typical expenses to be claimed

- Medical aid contributions
- Therapy expenses
- School fees (Special needs schools only)
- Nappies
- Caregiver remuneration
- Assistive devices
- Certain travel fees

The categories in which SARS will consider disabilities are:

- Physical impairments
- Visual impairments
- Hearing impairments
- Mental impairments
- Communication impairments
- Intellectual impairments

Learners could qualify in any one of these categories or in more than one and this will need to be confirmed by a qualified medical practitioner.

We would love to assist learner's parents with their disability medical tax credits claims and also work together with schools such as yours. One of the options you could consider is where we come present (either physical or online) to parents a session to better understand what they can claim, how they should claim and what supporting documents SARS would require.
